Morningside is affiliated with the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and is a member of the Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC).

The GPAC is a competitive league comprised of 11 institutions from Iowa, Nebraska, and South Dakota. The Morningside Mustangs, who began competing in GPAC athletic events in 2003, have quickly made a name for themselves as a dominant team in many areas. Morningside shared the GPAC All-Sports Trophy in 2006-07 and won the All-Sports Trophy outright in 2007-08. The Mustangs won NAIA Division II Women's Basketball National Championships in 2004, 2005, and 2009. Jake Stevenson was the 2007 NAIA 184 lb. National Champion in the sport of wrestling. Since joining the GPAC, the Mustangs have won regular season conference championships in football, volleyball, men's and women's soccer, men's and women's basketball, wrestling, and softball and have won GPAC post-season tournament titles in volleyball, men's and women's basketball, baseball, and softball.

Morningside President John Reynders said, "Intercollegiate athletics should enrich the college experience for our students. I believe that the GPAC membership adds another dimension to the Morningside experience by allowing us to compete with neighboring institutions and by strengthening our regional ties."
